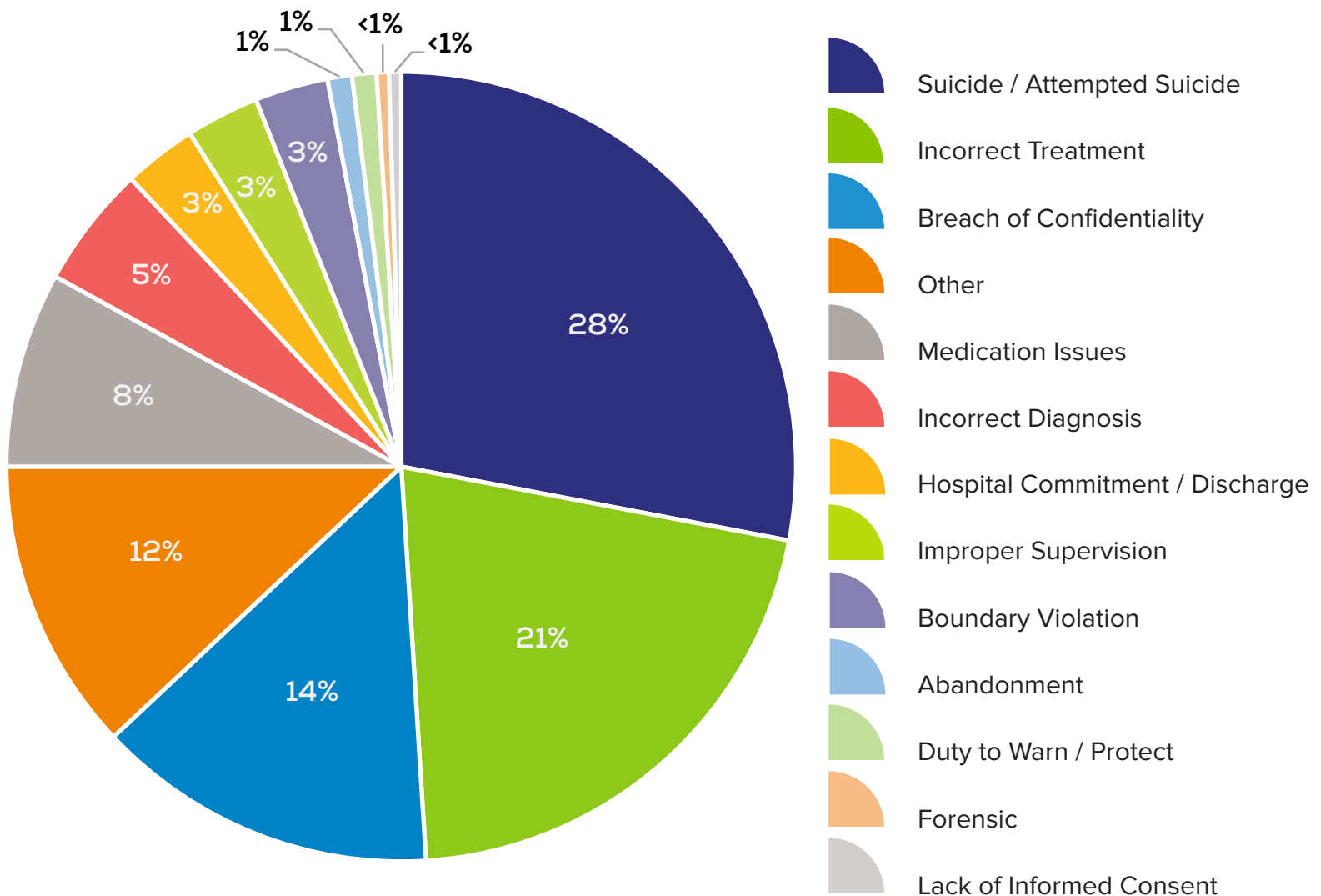

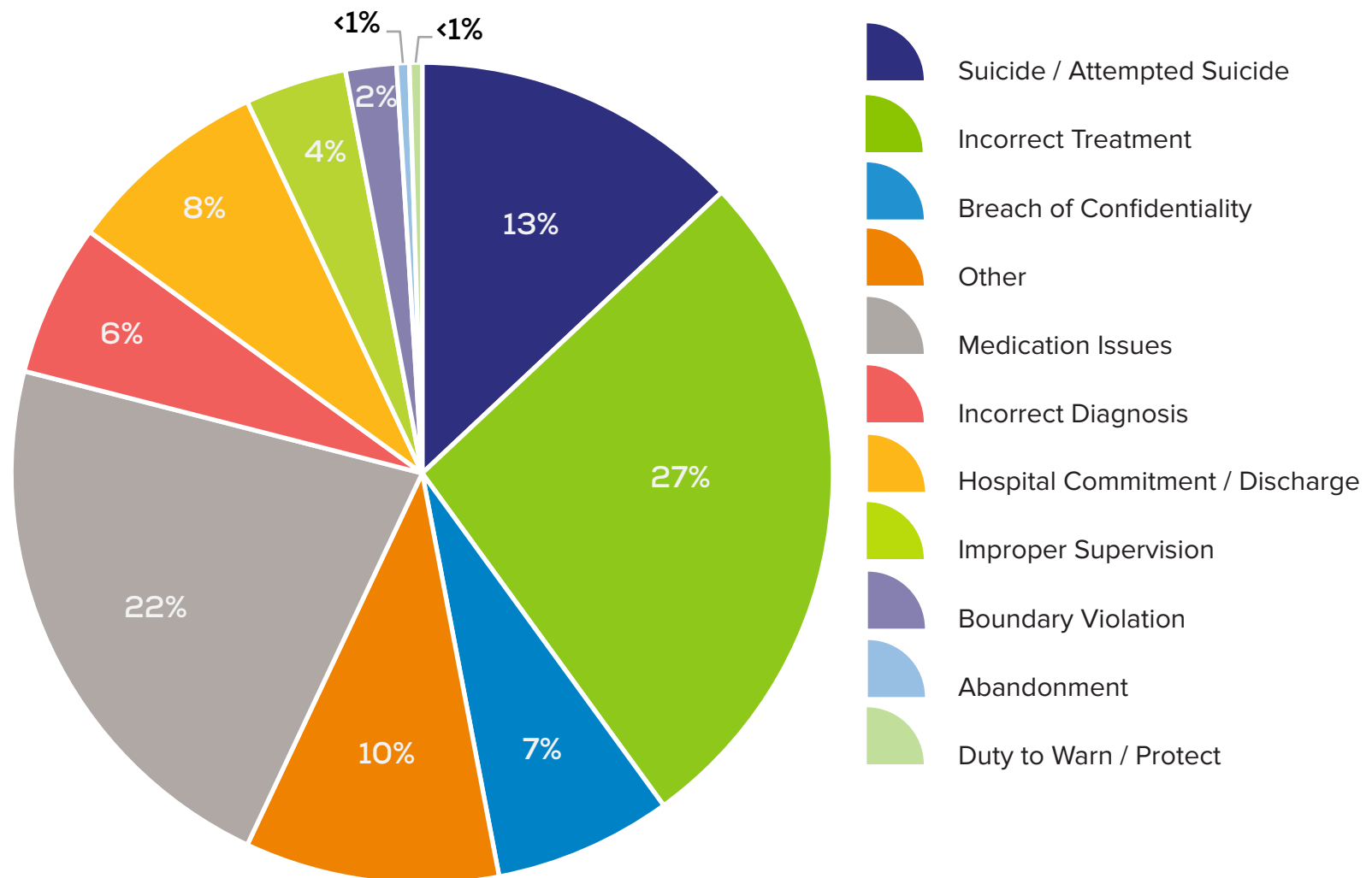
- “Primary allegation” is the main allegation by plaintiffs’ attorneys of what the psychiatrist did wrong
